- If you find any damage to the external cables, and electrical parts, please ask a qualified electrician to replace it.

Installation

- Take care when handling and installing to avoid damage to the product.
- Avoid mounting the fitting on a damp surface such as a newly painted or plastered area as this may cause discoloration of the finish

Cleaning Instructions and Care

- Take extra care when cleaning and assembling.
- Do not use any chemical or abrasive agents to clean the shade

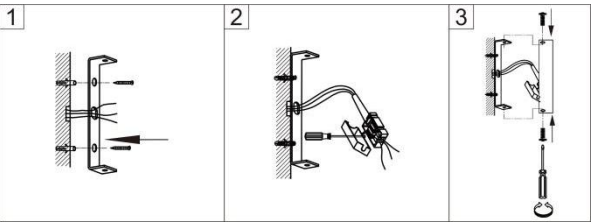
General Assembly

Part 1: Prepare

- Unpack your new fixture
- Turn off the power
- Check your support
- Check the junction box

Part 2: Installation

1. Make sure that the power source is still accessible.
2. Determine the wall light's position. To ensure accuracy, first, draw the hole's position on the wall surface using the metal bracket before drilling holes in the wall surface to fit the wall mounting light.
3. Install the raw plugs to the wall.
4. Install the metal bracket onto the wall using the screws.
5. Use the connector block or lightbox to connect the wall's circuitry to the main power supply.
6. Assemble the cables and drivers in the wall canopy, then secure it in place.



7. Turn the power back on.
8. Complete the installation.
